

# The Situation




We wanted to create an app for us to be able to reliably keep track of people's records and to award the higher ranking employees every month with a small celebration!


# GOALS of the App:



# Leaderboard/ Homepage

#### Main Features:


- Shows a summary of the top employees right away in comparison to everyone else
- Can access a hamburger menu for filters
  - Can see other people's ranking, photo,
    name, and number of matches won
- Can access the user profile in upper right corner
- By clicking on the user's space, you can view more details



# **Specific User Page**

### Main Features:

- Shows user's photo, name, ID
- Can click to invite them to a match
- Can click to view their specific detailed stats such as win-rate, losses, averages, and more
- Can view the user's recent matches that they have submitted to the app
  - Can filter by date (today, past week, past month, etc.)
  - Can filter by type of match (singles or doubles)
  - Clicking on a match will show you more details
- Can go back to the leaderboard using back button



## **Specific Match Page**

#### Main Features:

- Shows the overall results (score)
- Shows the players who participated (photos, and names)
- Shows if the match was a "best of" such as a best of 3 matches and the score of that
- Shows the type of match (singles or doubles)
- Shows the date and time if filled out by the users
- Can go back using X button
